The choice of a particular orthopedic design depends on how many of all healthy teeth are in the oral cavity. In this case, the product should fully fulfill its functions and not feel uncomfortable.



If there is an opportunity to tie an orthopedic design, the dentist can only install a textile system. It differs not only in aesthetic appearance, but also in quality. But which dental prostheses should be put better if there is no tooth? In this case, completely removable structures are suitable. This is the only alternative for the display of both or one Jag. They usually produce similar designs from nylon or acrylic. It is worth noting that the manufactured prosthetics technology has undergone a number of changes. As a result, the products are becoming more durable and accurate. Improved models are currently more practical and like an unreliable support in the oral cavity, as well as an unsatisfactory appearance.

Dental prostheses made on the basis of modern technologies have a high degree of wear resistance. With proper care and compliance with all hygiene rules, these orthopedic structures can last long enough. In this case, the color and density of the product practically does not change. It is worth noting that the structures that could soon be completely removed were carried out taking into account all the wishes of the client and, of course, the individual characteristics of the oral cavity.

So what do the best dental prostheses mean with the loss of all teeth? However, many patients doubt the reliability of strengthening structures that can be completely removed. To keep the prosthesis strong, they must be placed in implants placed in the jaw. Of course, there is a more expensive option. In this case, prostheses equipped with special protivogases are installed. However, it is not recommended that such constructions are not placed on the lower jaw, which is different from the upper movement from the top. It can be said that dental prostheses are no worse than natural teeth. Adaptation to similar products is carried out quickly and painlessly.

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ACRYLIC OR NYLON?

- 1. Which prostheses are the best today: acrylic or nylon? It is very difficult to answer this question one by one. To understand this and understand which dental procedures are best, it is necessary to take into account all the advantages and disadvantages of the product.
- 2. 1. Flexibility and, of course, easily. These indicators affect the strength of the structures. For example, nylon dentures are very flexible, soft and lightweight using materials. However, such structures are very difficult to break. In terms of flexibility and strength, acrylic prostheses are inferior to Nylon prostheses. But such designs are able to maintain their shape for a long time. In addition, acrylic prostheses have a low weight.
- 3. 2. Hygiene. This indicator is very important for many. Nylon orthopedic structures do not emit odors, are non-toxic, and also do not absorb moisture. Acrylic prostheses only have a porous structure. This is due to the fact that a large amount of bacteria accumulates on their surface, which can lead to the development of inflammatory processes in the oral cavity.
- 4. 3. Appearance. What dental prostheses are better to put on? Nylon designs match color and shape. In addition, they are able to maintain their aesthetic appearance for a long time. The disadvantage of these prostheses is at the intersection of the holes. Acrylic is associated with detachable leaves, which can be chosen not only as a shape, but also as a color.
- 5. 4. Hypoallergenic. In this regard, nylon structures have a bio-harmony that may not be said about acrylic prostheses. They can cause a local and general allergic reaction.
- 6. 5. Price. Nylon removable dentures are more expensive than acrylic. The problem is that they are produced abroad. If we compare the cost of



implantation and the installation of removable dentures, then the last method of prosthetics can be called democratic.

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
